PLAN AND WRITE PRACTICE QUESTIONS

Practise what you are going to have to do in your exams! The question won't say 'write everything you know about...' it will be specific and have a set formula. Learn how many points you need for each type of question and revise the right amount of points you need to know.

Make sure you know the key words for each type of question e.g. 'explain', 'analyse', 'evaluate' and have a strategy for how to answer each which allows you to focus your answer.

Memorise hooks like PEEL to help you do this.

Plan longer questions and then use these plans as revision notes! 'A journey of a thousand miles begins with one step' Lao Tzu
