## To help my child at college, I understand that:

- If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to college;
- If my child, or another child in the group, shows symptoms of COVID-19 at college, I will ensure my child is collected from college immediately, ensure the child is tested for COVID-19 and provide evidence of a negative test prior to their return to college;
- Inform the college if you are contacted by the "Track and Trace" app immediately;
- My child must bring all their learning items into college;
- My child will not ask to or share any equipment in school – The college cannot give out any equipment during COVID-19 restrictions;
- I will need to remind my child about social distancing rules and remind my child they must endeavour to do this successfully;
- My child will need to use good respiratory and hand hygiene;
- I will ensure my child wears clean clothing every day and that they have washed between each college day;
- I will read all letters/messages/emails that are sent;
- I need to inform the college immediately of any changes to parents/carers and emergency contacts details;
- I understand that if my child is deemed unsafe, he/she will be sent home and cannot return to college until they can be safe;
- I will ensure my child will not share food or drink with any other student

## I will do my best to:

- Adhere to the social distancing rules in class and on the college site;
