

## **ENTRY REQUIREMENTS – September 2026**

## A-Level:

- Minimum requirement <u>7 GCSE</u> or equivalent passes at grades 9-4 in an appropriate range of subjects, including Maths and English Language at grade 4 or above
- We will accept 1 BTEC at Merit level as one GCSE equivalent
- Where a student continues on to an A-Level from a GCSE subject, it is advisable for a student to have a minimum of a grade 5.

## **Applied (3 Applied Subjects only):**

- Minimum requirement <u>5 GCSE</u> or equivalent passes at grades 9-4 in an appropriate range of subjects we will accept <u>1 BTEC at Merit level</u> as one GCSE equivalent
- Mathematics and English Language grades 9-4

There may, however, be circumstances when adjustments may be appropriate in the light of particular individual circumstances.

## Some individual subjects have specific entry requirements:

- Applied Science require a grade 5 or above in GCSE Maths and a grade 5 or above in GCSE Science is required
- English Language and Literature; English Literature require GCSE grade 6 or above in English Language and Literature
- Maths/Further Maths require a GCSE grade 7 or above in Maths
- Biology, Chemistry and Physics require a GCSE grade 6 or above in Science and Maths
- Economics/Business we would normally expect students to have achieved a GCSE grade 5 or above in Maths
- Geography we would normally expect students to have achieved a GCSE grade 5
  or above in Maths
- Law it is preferable to have achieved at least a GCSE grade 6 in one of your English GCSEs or alternatively in a humanities/essay based subject
- Politics require a GCSE grade 5 or above in English
- Psychology we would normally expect students to have achieved a GCSE grade 5
  or above in Maths
