ASSIGNMENT CHECKLIST:



30 PHOTOS

Over the summer make 30 extraordinary photographs of everything and anything that catches your attention. Try to begin seeing the extraordinary in the ordinary world that surrounds you.

- Photograph things as you find them – don't interfere or set things up.
- You can't shoot all 30 photos of the same thing or at the same time and place.

TIPS

- Treat this task like a visual diary
- Try making some of your photographs in the golden hour – just after sunrise or before sunset
- Look closely at the way light enters and transforms a space or room
- Look for reflected light as well as direct light – light that bounces/reflects off other materials and surfaces onto your subject
